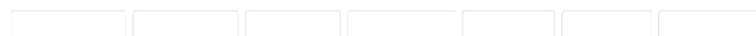

SHARE Foundation will file criminal charges against those responsible for the removal of humorous video clips from the internet in which the leading role has the First Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia Aleksandar Vucic.

Independent Association of Journalists of Serbia, the Independent Association of Journalists of Vojvodina and the SHARE Foundation strongly condemned the attempts of censorship of content on the Internet related to Serbian Deputy Prime Minister and the leader of the Serbian Progressive Party, Aleksandar Vucic.

Thanks to numerous false reports regarding abuse of copy rights of RTS's video, many videos, showing Aleksandar Vucic as he carries a child to the helicopter in Feketic, saving it from the bus captured by snow, but subtitled in a humorous way, have been removed. It is believed that false reports came from the SNS activists.

One of the members of the SNS and coordinator of their internet team, Mario Maletic, when confronted with the allegations that SNS activists are involved in report spam, answered that "mind triumphs, but an army of men comes handy as well".

SHARE will file charges against company *Matricon*, by whose report the "politically misfit" videos were removed. *Matricon* is licensed representative for Serbia of the Bulgarian company *KVZ Music*, the company which is registered in Austria, "Blic" reported. Also, SHARE will submit a Request for Information of Public Importance to RTS in order to determine its role in this case.
